



Founded in 1862, the Ramblers are Eton College's old boys' cricket team. Each year, we elect players from the School's XI, XXII and XXXIII, as well as a handful of other keen cricketers to become members of the Club. The Ramblers have had several notable players in recent memory, including Matthew Fleming (Kent, England and MCC President 2016-17), Alex Loudon (Kent, Warwickshire and England) and James Bruce (Hampshire). Off the field, notable members include Damian Lewis and Bear Grylls.

*The Club maintains one of the largest fixture lists of any old boys' team, with 44 games (including 3 golf matches) scheduled for 2024. As well as these fixtures in the UK, the Ramblers frequently head further afield on tour, with South Africa, Rwanda and Sri Lanka all recent destinations. One of the highlights of the Club's season is taking part in the Cricketer Cup competition, fought out by all the leading public-school teams. The Ramblers have lifted the trophy twice since its inception in 1967 and currently sit 11th in the all-time order of merit (out of 37 teams). Wormsley is **certainly** one of the most cherished fixtures in the Rambler calendar, with captains of the side playing Sir Paul Getty's XI usually bombarded with applications to play in such a prestigious game.*
